Learn To Dance Covid-19 Procedures to be followed by Teachers or Hirers

One Way System

Entrance into the studio is by the main door for teachers or main hirer only. All students or visitors should on arrival follow the footprints and **LearnToDance** signage (or other appropriate signage) to our side door.

If a queue forms please advise that social distancing measures are recommended but no longer compulsory. You can use the footsteps distancing for guidance.

The exit is on the opposite side of the studio and the keys can be found on the bookcase.

Please ensure visitors do not congregate by the side entrance or exit.

Masks

Masks are no longer compulsory however we would recommend them being worn when heading down to the toilets or entering the kitchen area.

It is recommended that Teachers/Hirers should wear face shields or masks if they need to come within 2m of a visitor or student or when moving otherwise around the building when inhabited.

Temperature Checks

Please check your temperature upon arrival at the studio and that of any students or visitors.

If the thermometer indicates a high temperature (the screen will flash red) wait a few moments and check again.

If the temperature is still high unfortunately access to the studio is not permitted. In the case of hirers please check your temperature before arriving at the studio.

Thermometer should be sanitised after use.

COVID-pass

Learn To Dance are currently trialling the use of the COVID-pass as an entry requirement to the studio. Visitors are required to display either their COVID-pass (via the NHS app or as a download/print-out from NHS online), a negative COVID test result within the preceding 48hrs, or a proof of double vaccination status.

Hirers are recommended to implement the same scheme but it is not compulsory.

Social Distancing

Whilst Social Distancing is no longer set in law we have set our capacity for classes at 24 students whilst we trial removing restrictions.

Our teachers are currently trialling partnering solo dancers in personal tuition sessions only. They will be minimising contact to 15mins max at a time, and for a maximum of 50% of a lesson. In group classes we will be allowing contact between solo students if they wish.

Hirers should still minimise contact or close proximity (under 2m) to individuals outside of their household.

Hand Sanitiser

We have a number of hand sanitiser stations around the building and we ask that these are taken advantage of before and after sessions and if visiting the toilets.

Regular Cleaning

Please use the portable fogging device, anti-viral spray, or wipes to sanitise the areas that visitors have come into contact with throughout the day.

At the end of the day, or end of your session for hirers, please wipe down equipment (including stereo, cupboard, and thermometer) with disinfectant wipes.

Feeling Ill? Please Stay Away

If you are displaying any flu-like symptoms, or have come into contact with anyone suffering from Covid-19 in the preceding 14 days, please do not visit the studio.

Also confirm with individuals upon arrival that they have also not come into contact.

NHS Test & Trace Records and App

We have a QR code poster for use with the [NHS Test & Trace App](#). On arrival at the studio the poster can be found on the board by the entrance, please scan the QR code to 'check in' and advise visitors to do the same.

All visitors to the Learn To Dance studio should leave a contact name and phone number for test & trace purposes if not already registered on our system.

Regular Testing

We recommend twice weekly lateral flow tests for all staff and students. This is not compulsory but should be considered. If a test is positive please do not come to the studio but do arrange for a PCR test to be performed.
